Key Stage 2 Key Links:

- 1. Worldviews
- 2. <u>Theology is about believing</u> -where beliefs come from how they have changed over time how they are applied differently
- 3. <u>Philosophy is about thinking</u>. It is about finding out how and whether things make sense
- 4. Impact of beliefs on individuals, communities and societies

Year 9 Link to Year 8:

- 1. Why can belief be so divisive?
- 2. Can religion be a force of good?
- 3. Sikhism in the Community An exploration of the role of faith at a grass roots / community level with a particular focus on Sikhism

Year 7 Link to Key Stage 2:

- 1. <u>Worldviews</u> How time and space impact upon religion and worldviews E.g. Origins of the Universe
- What is belief / what is religion and how evidence of belief can be traced back to the dawns of time (SACRE Link: changes, grand narratives)
- 3. How have individuals and belief shaped how we understand our universe? E.g Charles Darwin, Georges Lemaitre

Year 10 Link to Year 9:

- AQA Religious Studies Christianity / Islam
- Paper 2 Religion, Peace and Conflict links to Year 9 - Why can belief be so divisive?
- Paper 1 Christian and Islam beliefs and Practices
- Christian and Islam teachings about sin, salvation, heaven and hell link to the year 9 unit, can religion be a force of good.

Year 8 Link to Year 7:

- <u>Belonging and Believing</u> A unit exploring how ideas and beliefs are expressed in diverse ways / rites of passage– Judaism, Christianity and Islam focus links to Yr 7 worldviews / what is belief
- How did faith migrate? Explore the historical origins of key faiths and the events, individuals and processes that allowed ideas and beliefs to migrate – Links to what is belief / what is religion
- 3. Is everyone capable of being good?
